ELLENBROOK NEW TOWN - City of Swan, Western Australia

Client: LWP Property

The most awarded urban development project in Australia, Ellenbrook New Town is a joint venture involving the State Housing Authority of Western Australia and a private sector consortium. The project comprises 1,200 hectares of land and is located approximately 20 kilometres north-east of the Perth CBD, within the City of Swan. On current projections, Ellenbrook will ultimately contain 10,500 dwellings accommodating a population of 30,000. Construction of the first of seven villages framed around a mixed use town centre commenced in 1994. The first phase of a 140 hectare town centre is currently under construction. Completion of the project is anticipated in 2015. The annual development rate (400-500 lots) to date has represented approximately 10% of Perth's residential land supply. In excess of 6,000 residential lots had been sold to June 2006 with 4,000 dwellings constructed.

YANCHEP - TWO ROCKS, WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Client: Tokyu Corporation

At 7550 hectares, Yanchep – Two Rocks is the largest single urban development project under construction in Australia and will ultimately accommodate 155,000 people and 55,000 jobs. The masterplan is structured on a hierarchy of activity centres interconnected with high frequency public transport. At the heart of the development and at the terminus of the Perth northern rail line is the Yanchep City Centre, which will be the largest centre outside the Perth CBD with over 500,000sqm of commercial floorspace and 23,500 jobs. The plan also includes over 200 hectares of industrial and technology parks; 100 hectares of regional open space; 14 high schools; a regional hospital and health campus; conservation reserves; and a network of greenway corridors. The 16km of Indian Ocean coastline will comprise a mixture of recreational facilities, marinas, tourist hubs and conservation areas and the masterplan provides guidance for compact, mixed-use, walkable neighbourhoods that foster a strong sense of community interaction.

DUBAI WATERFRONT - DUBAI, UAE

Client: Nakheel

Nakheel commissioned Roberts Day to undertake a peer review of the entire 12,000ha Waterfront project in November 2006. Waterfront will provide the foundation of new city with an estimated population of 1.5 million people – twice the size of Hong Kong Island. It is being developed on the last 15km of natural coastline in Dubai and will provide more than 70km of coastline in total. Roberts Day was responsible for leading a series of visioning, strategy and design workshops, taking the form of a peer review over various portions of the Waterfront project area, including The Palm Jebel Ali, Crescent Islands, Phases 1, 2 and 3, G9 and the CBD.

The Palm Jebel Ali is a 1,200ha man-made archipelago in the eastern Dubai emirate, adjacent to the Abu Dhabi border. In positioning the project as a leading global lifestyle destination, Roberts Day was responsible for leading and formulating the vision and broad development strategy, as well as a design framework over two intensive eight-day working sessions involving Nakheel and a wide range of subject matter experts. This effort culminated in a vision and strategy report, and three detailed planning and design reports to prescribe and direct future development of the site. Veneto, Phase 3 of Nakheel's Waterfront project is located 35km north-west of Dubai adjacent to the Abu Dhabi border. RIPLEY VALLEY - IPSWICH, QUEENSLAND**Client: Ipswich City Council**

Ripley Valley is a planned major city outside Brisbane covering 100km², and representing the largest new city project in Australia. It will be home to more than 150,000 residents and host 100,000 new jobs in the largest concentration of commercial land in Australia. The Ipswich City Council appointed Roberts Day to lead a team of consultants in preparing the strategy and structure plan for the project. Various neighbourhoods proposed within the city structure are all 'transit ready' and the design of the central business district precincts are tightly integrated with passenger rail. The strategy for the new city gives direction for sustained growth in commerce and social capital, while balancing the need to protect and complement the natural environment. The resulting plan allows the many complex layers and dimensions of a new community to be logically and sensitively accommodated within the site.
